Developed under the International Programme for Action on Climate, the CAPMF tracks 130 policy variables, aggregated into 56 key climate actions and policies for the 1990-2023 period for OECD and OECD partner countries as well as the European Union as a block. OECD Policy Instruments for the Environment (PINE)	The OECD PINE database started in the 1990s, initially with a limited policy scope. Today, the database covers 5 policy instrument types: taxes and fees, subsidies, tradable permits and offsets, deposit-refund schemes and voluntary approaches across 22 environmental domains. PINE is a structured relational database designed for statistical analysis, providing comprehensive information for each policy instrument through a wide range of quantitative and qualitative variables. NDC Tracking Tool	Operational since 2022, FAO's NDC Tracking Tool is openly available and allows users to collect information required to track progress made in implementing a country's NDC.
